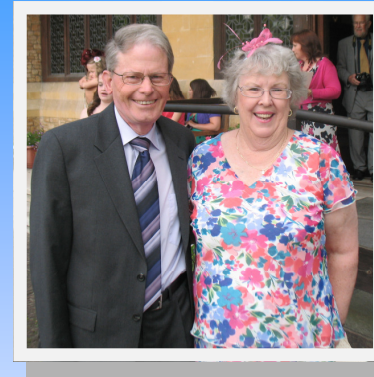
theme

Murray Dixon was ordained in the New Zealand Anglican Church where he served as parish pastor and air force chaplain before pioneering Prayer for Israel in New Zealand with his wife, Rosemary. For 20 years they led prayer tours to meet the Body of Messiah in Israel and served in an itinerant teaching ministry to the Body of Christ. Murray authored 'Israel, Land of God's Promise,' and 'Whose Promised Land?', a history textbook for secondary schools. Prior to his appointment as pastor at Ellel Ministries Pierrepont (Surrey, England) he served as the Rector of Christ Church, Jerusalem.
